

UNTIL HE COMES

We have access to incredible technology in the palms of our hands. There is an app on my phone that allows me to see a word in scripture in the original language and do the kind of word study that would have required a library decades ago. I have another app on my phone that can track the International Space Station. As I write this, it lets me know that tomorrow morning at 4:32 it will appear 27 degrees above the horizon as a white dot moving east across the sky and disappear 3 minutes and 45 seconds later. It is accurate every time. It still shocks me that I can watch the ISS travelling overhead at 17,500 miles per hour.

Sometimes while I watch that white dot travel across the sky knowing it is about to disappear, I think of the apostles at the beginning of the book of Acts. As Jesus ascended into heaven and out of their sight, they still stood there staring into the sky so intently that they did not realize that visitors had come with a message. "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven" (Acts 1:11). It's time to stop staring into the sky and get to work. Jesus is coming back.

His apostles might have expected Jesus to return in their lifetimes. The early church appeared to expect that as well. Peter writes to people who might have even wondered why He was taking so long to return. "But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance" (2 Peter 3:9). Our nearly 2000 years since has only been a couple days. It might seem slow to us, but God has a different way of seeing that.

As we take the Lord's Supper this week, we will continue to proclaim not only His death and resurrection, but also his return. "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death **until he comes**" (1 Corinthians 11:26).

Live for Him. Proclaim His love. Until He comes.

Briana Lane had surgery in Oklahoma City on Thursday. Please keep her in your prayers.


The Power For Today study booklets for July, August, and September are located in the clear wall racks at the north and south entry doors. There will also be a few at the welcome desk.

The Ladies Prayer Group meets on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of each month at 4pm. They will meet next on <u>June 23rd</u>.


