

#### HIGHER THINGS

As Colossians 3 begins Paul writes, "If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God." We have our hearts set on many things throughout life. As kids, our hearts were set on toys or places we would like to go. As we grew, our hearts may have been set on someone we loved or the job we desired. As we get older, our hearts may be set on the welfare of our families and friends. Some of those things seem trivial and others seem important. God wants us to have something above all of them: things above.

Sometimes we go to extremes and forget that there are things here that should be on our hearts. Later in the same chapter he talks about the importance of selfless interpersonal relationships. But "things above" should be a greater focus. He wants us to concentrate on the example of Christ and on following him. He wants our perspective to be one that places Him above everything else. When we do that, we will find ourselves having the right priorities when it comes to things on Earth, because Jesus had the right priorities here.

We know that what we read in Colossians is right, but we can still quickly lose focus and misalign our priorities. God knows that too. Through Paul He reminds us of a great tool to set us back in the right direction. In verse 16, Paul continues, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God." We see three important things about scripture in that verse.

- 1. **Scripture should <u>dwell</u> in us.** The Greek word *oikos* (house) is the root of dwell. We are literally to be a place where scripture is at home in us.
- 2. Scripture should dwell <u>richly</u> in us. The Greek word *plousios* (richly) is often translated abundantly. We should have a wealth of scripture that we are ready to share.
- **3. Scripture leads to <u>action</u> in us.** As the word dwells, it leads us to teaching, admonishing, singing and thankfulness to God. Higher things.

Are you seeking higher things? Let His word dwell in you richly and spur action, then you will be sure to find things above.

**There will be** a Safety Team shooting practice on Saturday, **July 20th**, at 6pm at the Ada Police Shooting Range.


